

## ABC Health Sustainability Plan

Sustainability Plan: Clean Air Improvement Study (CAIRS): Air Quality in ABC Health Neighborhoods

This sustainability plan draws out a plan for community growth and development around the air quality project between ABC Health and Local Research University.

### Community

- ABC Health will create a new Community Coalition group made up of community members who update information sessions with new findings about air quality in the community and who plan outreach to spread awareness in the community. They also seek to acquire resources for the community (e.g., inhalers, financial advisement support, asthma attack recovery skills, support groups). After a year of work, the Coalition will evaluate effectiveness and consider other activities that might be useful.
- LRU will continue to stay involved through regular meetings and collaboration with the Community Coalition. At the one-year evaluation, they will discuss effectiveness, needs, and opportunities together.

### Financial\*

- ABC Health and LRU have agreed to partner on creating and hosting fundraisers and pursuing additional grants from various sources to continue funding the air quality efforts.
- ABC Health is looking to create a full-time employee position to cover the coordination of these new efforts.
- ABC Health and LRU would like to apply for additional grant funding.
- ABC Health will also evaluate if there are other organizations whose missions align with ours that we might be able to partner with in the long term to keep the project going.
